



Check your pension record information

Your pension record contains data on all your employment relationships in Finland. The record shows the names of your employers, your employee and self-employed earnings as well as how much pension you have earned by the end of 2018. In other words, your pension record does not show the amount of your final pension, but the information on your pensionable earnings so far. Please check that your data is accurate, as the pension record is used to calculate your future pension.

Under the MYEL insurance you accrue pension at an annual rate of 1,5 per cent of your MYEL earnings. After the pension reform of 2017, the retirement age will rise gradually (by two years) to 65 by 2025.

Choose the e-service

If you are between 18–59 and reside in Finland you will receive a printed pension record from your pension provider to your home address every third year. From 60 years of age you will be sent the record every year.
